



'My Life in Toy Theatre'

Talk by Dr Alan Powers

Alan Powers is an art historian and Chairman of Pollock's Toy Museum Trust, London.

Pollock's is the continuation of the last Victorian toy theatre business in London. Alan has been involved in it for most of his life and is now part of a group working to establish the museum on a new footing. Many will recall the exhibition 'Cardboard Gothic' mounted by Alan and his colleagues at Strawberry Hill in 2022, which showed 14 theatres, including the oldest surviving one known.
